 Crisp and lively with melon & citrus fruit, balanced by acacia and weighty stone fruits on the palate

Riesling, Gustav Lorentz, Alsace, 2015 42
 Pale yellow colour with green tints, discrete nose, muscat fruit with mineral notes of flint and white pepper on the finish.

Bergerie de L'Hortus, Domaine Orliac, Pic St Loup, Languedoc, 2016 42
 Ripe fruit coming through from the Chardonnay, a crisp backbone of acidity from the Sauvignon and a peachy delicacy from the Viognier. A really well balanced, zippy wine.

Bourgogne-Aligote, Domaine Stephane Magnien, 2015 44
 The Aligote grape is fresh round and fruity. Well made Burgundy, interesting alternative to Chardonnay

Sancerre, Domaine de la Rossignole, Loire Valley, 2016 47
 A subtle and elegant wine made by a talented winemaker. A great example of a real Sancerre and great representation of a classy Loire Sauvignon

Saint Veran, Domaine de la Croix Senaillet, Burgundy, 2015 54
 Intense, mineral, with a great selection of citrus and passion fruit, a Chardonnay at its best - Organic

Chablis, Gerard Tremblay, Burgundy, 2016 50
 Very mineral with trademark green and red apple and oyster-shell aromas. The palate is whistle-fresh with lime, apple and more minerality. A perfectly balanced, fleshy and ripe style this vintage.

 A single vineyard producing a fine, elegant Chardonnay, with long and toasty finish

Anjou Litus, Domaine Eric Morgat, 2014 80

Red fruits, oak and sweet spices. Classic Rioja Crianza style, flavourful and fresh. Perfect with chargrilled red meats
- Clos Roja, Priorat, Spain, 2012 40
Classic Priorat wine made from old-vine Garnacha and Cariñena, and has concentrated aromas of liquorice, tar and brandied cherries and smokey character
- Albaha, Envinata, Garnacha Tintorera, Castilla La Mancha, 2014 44
A brilliant of wine from trailblazing new producers in Spain. Fragrant, pure and full of flavour but most of all true to its origin and terroir. Sour cherry, red berries come forward on the palate. Medium body with a fresh lingering finish. Ideal with grilled meats.

From the Telmo Rodriguez family estate in Rioja. Ripe fruit and round tannins. This stunning example of big Rioja is spicy with creamy oak. A complex and long finish.

Mouth filling and rich, this wine is brimming with ripe black fruit but has a softness of tannins. A classic Malbec from Mendoza
